

Benjamin Disraeli 1804 - 1881

Benjamin Disraeli was the 1st Earl of Beaconsfield and lived at Hughenden Manor, in Buckinghamshire. He served in government for three decades, twice as Prime Minister.

Disraeli's greatest lasting achievement was the creation of the modern Conservative Party after the Corn Laws schism of 1846. Before and during his political career, Disraeli was also well-known as a literary and social figure.

He was elevated to the House of Lords in 1876 when Queen Victoria (who liked Disraeli both personally and politically) made him Earl of Beaconsfield and Viscount Hughenden.
